CHRIST:

MY CHILD, do your best to follow My words in your daily life. Do not depend on human sympathy or admiration to go out living a good life. You know what is right. Do it regardless of the pleasure or pain which it gives you. Let your faith and charity be your strength.

2. If I give you heavenly consolation for every good deed which you perform, your life would hardly be proof of greatness. It would be very easy and very appealing to anyone, even the most selfish.
